



# Casillero del Diablo

## RESERVA ESPECIAL

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Soils rich in red clay and granite give rise to **Reserva Especial** in Maule, 350 kilometres south of Santiago de Chile. Clay has been a key element in many creations throughout human history, and today it has an important role in making this wine.

The **clay-loam soils** over a granitic base in our vineyards contribute structure and character to this wine, while the zone's coastal breezes and constant sunshine produce the rich acidity and fresh fruit that enables us to obtain a vibrant and enchantingly elegant Cabernet Sauvignon.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

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### AGEING

Aged in French and American oak barrels from 8 to 10 months..

### COLOUR

Bright, intense, violet-red.

### AROMA

This wine expresses delicate notes of plum and black cherries, which accompany a soft, delicate toasted notes from the barrel ageing.

### PALATE

This is a very elegant and well-structured wine, with a marked character and strong tannins. It is characterised by the prominent expression of fruits, specifically plum and black cherry. Its ageing in barrels gives this wine a greater degree of complexity.

### PAIRING

Ideal with roasted red meats and aged cheeses.
